INTRODUCTION

DoctorS Nonprofit Consulting (DNC) was hired by Art & Creativity for Healing Inc. (ACFH) in May of 2020 to provide an outcome evaluation for the 2018-2020 Healing for Heroes and their Families program data for participants in ACFH workshops. ACFH has facilitated these "Art4Healing®" workshop programs at more than 40 hospitals, treatment centers, military bases, schools and non-profit agencies throughout Southern California. Since 2000, more than 80,000 children and adults have participated in these classes and workshops.

METHOD

For this project, ACFH staff entered the data from their surveys into an online computer program. DNC then downloaded data spreadsheets in both excel and SPSS formats. DNC reviewed the data and addressed any data entry concerns with ACFH staff. SPSS statistical software was used for the evaluation process which was conducted by consultants in July 2020. For this project, the program's data collection procedures were reviewed. Initially, a series of frequency tables were run to establish basic program statistics. Following this, a series of correlations and one-way analysis of variance (ANOVA) tests were computed on the data. A full statistical report of the test outcomes is included in appendix A. Correlations are useful in determining how closely one variable relates to another variable. ANOVAs are useful for comparing differences between groups.

KEY FINDINGS

Overall, 98.72% of the Healing for Heroes & their Families participants reported that they were satisfied with their ACFH workshop.

From the adult questionnaire, 85.32% of adult participants strongly agreed that the workshop was great. Eighty-two percent of participants strongly agreed that the workshop helped them express their emotions. Seventy-nine percent of participants strongly agreed that they felt better after the workshop. Ninety percent of adults strongly agreed that the instructor was approachable

From the child/teen questionnaires, 84.43% of participants strongly agreed that the workshop was great. Seventy-four percent of participants strongly agreed that the workshop helped me share their feelings. Seventy-nine percent of participants strongly agreed that they felt better after the workshop. Eighty-five percent of participants strongly agreed that the instructor cared about them and 84.46% felt the instructor was on time.

When combining the adult and child/teen questionnaires, 85.09% of the participants strongly agreed that overall, they liked the workshop.

For future workshops, 93.83% of both children and adult participants agreed that they would refer a friend or family member to this workshop. In fact, 95.8% of all participants agreed that they themselves would take another workshop from the program.

The most selected reasons that the child participants took workshops was *I like art* (89.74%) and for adults *Anxiety/Stress* (81.45%) and *Sadness* (77.20%) were the most selected.

Camp Pendleton Wounded Warriors program participants rated higher than Expressing Feelings with Colors program participants on 1) *Emotional Expression*, 2) *Caring Instructor*, 3) *Instructor Time Management/Comfortable Sharing*, 4) *Effect of Workshop*, 5) *Willingness to refer a friend*, 6) *Interest in additional workshops*.

Wounded Warriors Battalion West reported higher scores compared to other location averages in 1) *How Great the Workshop*, 2) *Emotional Expression*, 3) *Instructor Time Management/Comfortable Sharing*, 4) *Effect of Workshop*, 5) *Willingness to refer a friend*, 6) *Interest in additional workshops*. In one area, San Onofre School reported significantly lower that the instructor was approachable and/or cared about them than the averages of all programs. Although there were differences in the overall satisfaction among the different programs, the differences were not significant and could be a result of statistical error.

The participants that identified as Asian American/Vietnamese reported 1) *liking the workshop more*, 2) *workshop helped express more*, and 3) *they felt better after taking the workshop than other ethnicities*. Additionally, the Asian American/Vietnamese participants felt the instructor was more approachable and appeared to care about participants and value their time more than other ethnicities. Finally, the clients that identified as Asian American/Vietnamese were more likely to refer a friend or family member. Those that were least likely to refer identified as *other* or *bi-racial*.

Overall, adult participant ratings were higher than children/teen participants. In fact, adult participants reported higher averages on 1) This workshop was great, 2) This workshop helped me share my feelings/express my emotions, 3) The instructor was approachable and appeared to care about the participants, 4) The instructor was on time and valued my time, 5) I feel better after taking this workshop, 6) I would tell a friend or family member to attend this workshop, 7) I want to take another Art & Creativity for Healing workshop, 8) Overall, I like this workshop/I am satisfied with this Art & Creativity for Healing workshop.

RESULTS


Overall Data Statistics

This data set consists of responses by 861 Healing for Heroes & their Families referred individuals who received ACFH services between the period of July 2018 and June 2020. Of those, participants either completed the adult survey (n=647) or the child survey (n=214). Generally, when working with statistical evaluation, we like to see a large sample. Data sets of this size (n=861) are generally regarded to be an accurate indicator of the measured items.


Frequency Tables


Sixty seven percent of Healing for Heroes & their Families participants completed the adult participant questionnaire. The remaining 33% were completed by children/teens. Approximately 1/3 of the participants indicated their age (n=313). The ages ranged from 6-52, with the average age being 23.04, for those participants who did include an age. It should be noted that less than 1 percent of the child questionnaire participants included their age (15 out of 214 participants) thus skewing the data to be older than the average age could be.

Caucasians made up 46.69% of participants (40% of child/teen; 47.28% adult) followed by Hispanic/Latino(a) American 21.15% (21.82 child/teen; 21.09% adult). See figure 1 and 2. However, 18.73% of the participants did not list their ethnicity. Please note that the actual ethnicity included in the figures below is for those that reported their ethnicity.



Q6 Fig 1. Ethnic Background - Child (n=55)






Over 39.88% of the adult participants indicated Camp Pendleton as their residence. Followed by 11.5% from Oceanside and 10.5% from San Clemente (see figure 3). As expected, the participants in this program come from multiple cities due to the nature of being in the military. This results in a larger "other" category. See figure 4 for a word cloud of the responses of the

other city locations. The child/teen participants were primarily located in Camp Pendleton (99.06%). See figure 5.


Q4 Fig. 3 City of Residence - Adults (n=647)




Q4 Fig. 4 Other Word Cloud Responses - Adults (n=214)


Q4 Fig. 5 City of Residence - Child (n=213)



Q5 Fig. 6 Location Sites -Adult (n=647)





Q5 Fig. 7 Location Sites -Child (n=214)


Q3 Fig 8. Workshop Title - Child (n=214)

The participants generally have multiple psychological reasons for attending the workshops. Each participant was asked to indicate all the reasons and then select their top reason for taking the class. The most selected reasons that the child participants took workshops was *I like art* (89.74%) and for adults *Anxiety/Stress* (81.45%) and *Sadness* (77.20%) were the most selected. See figures 10 and 11.




Q10 Fig 12. Healing for Heroes & their Families Program Weighted Averages of Outcomes - Adult (n=647)



From only the child/teen questionnaires, 84.43% of participants strongly agreed that the workshop was great. Seventy-four percent of participants strongly agreed that the workshop helped me share their feelings. Seventy-nine percent of participants strongly agreed that they felt better after the workshop. Eighty-five percent of participants strongly agreed that the instructor cared about them and 84.46% felt the instructor was on time.

Q10 Fig 13. Healing for Heroes & their Families Program Weighted Averages of Outcomes - Child (n=214)




When combining the adults and child/teen participants together, 85.09% of the participants strongly agreed that overall, they liked the workshop. For future workshops, 93.83% of both children and adult

participants agreed that they would refer a friend or family member to this workshop. In fact, 95.8% of all participants agreed that they themselves would take another workshop from the program.

Overall, it is significant to say that 98.72% of the Healing for Heroes & their Families participants reported that they were satisfied with their workshop.

The child participants were primarily referred by an agency (71.05%, child). The adult participants were primarily referred by a health care provider (58.97%), see figures 14 and 15.

Participants Correlations

Correlation (Pearson *r*) tests were run for data from the eight questions answered on the participant survey with a rating. Correlations are useful in determining how closely one variable relates to another variable. Tests for the child participants were run comparing: 1) This workshop was great, 2) This workshop helped me share my feelings/express my emotions, 3) The instructor was approachable and appeared to care about the participants, 4) The instructor was on time and valued my time, 5) I feel better after taking this workshop, 6) I would tell a friend or family member to attend this workshop, 7) I want to take another Art & Creativity for Healing workshop, 8) Overall, I like this workshop/ I am satisfied with this Art & Creativity for Healing workshop.

In seven of the eight rating variables listed above, there was a significant correlation for the child participant's data. This indicates that there is a strong correlation between each question and a reliable

questionnaire measuring workshop outcomes. The strongest correlation was *instructor cared about* me and *instructor was on time*. (r=.719, p <.01) responses. See detailed information in the Appendix.

ANOVA's

One-way analysis of variance (ANOVA) tests were computed on five categorical variables and eight numerical values for all the 2018-2020 data participants. ANOVAs use statistics to compare categorical variables and numerical variables. The three categorical variables were: 1) Workshop Title, 2) Workshop Location, and 3) Ethnicity. The eight numerical values were rates of: 1) How Great the Workshop, 2) Emotional Expression, 3) Caring Instructor, 4) Instructor Time Management/Comfortable Sharing, 5) Effect of Workshop, 6) Willingness to refer a friend, 7) Interest in additional workshops, and 8) Overall Satisfaction.

When looking at the significance of ANOVA results, anything less than .05 is generally acceptable in research. A score at less than .05 indicates that the differences in the mean values between these groups, given the sample size, is so large that similarly strong findings would be unlikely to recur by chance, even if we were replicated this study a thousand times.

Categorical Variable: Workshop Title

There was a one-way analysis of variance (ANOVA) test computed for the categorical variable of Healing for Heroes & Their Families location for the 2018-2020 participant data. The 2 Workshop titles for the Healing for Heroes and their Families programs were 1) Expressing Feelings with Color, and 2) Camp Pendleton Wounded Warriors. There were six differences reported between the two workshop titles and the 1-5 scaled outcomes (with 5 being the highest). The six significant differences were Camp Pendleton Wounded Warriors programs rated higher than Expressing Feelings with Colors on 1) Emotional Expression (Wounded Warriors, *M*=4.79, n=634; Average *M*=4.71, n=860; p=.000), 2) Caring Instructor (Wounded Warriors, *M*=4.89, n=634; Average *M*=4.87, n=857; p=.025), 3) Instructor Time Management/Comfortable Sharing (Wounded Warriors, *M*=4.90, n=633; Average *M*=4.87, n=857; p=.003), 4) Effect of Workshop (Wounded Warriors, *M*=4.72, n=634; Average *M*=4.72, n=858; p=.000), 5) Willingness to refer a friend (Wounded Warriors, *M*=4.82, n=634; Average *M*=4.72, n=858; p=.000), 6) Interest in additional workshops (Wounded Warriors, *M*=4.82, n=634; Average *M*=4.78, n=857; p=.004).

Categorical Variable: Workshop Location

There was a one-way analysis of variance (ANOVA) test computed for the categorical variable of Healing for Heroes & their Families location for the 2018-2020 participant data. The three programs were 1) San Onofre School, 2) Working Wardrobes, 3) Wounded Warriors and 3) Wounded Warrior Battalion West.

When combined with the children and adults, there was also 7 significant differences. The following seven differences are that the Wounded Warriors Battalion West reported higher scores compared to other location averages in 1) How Great the Workshop (Wounded Warriors Battalion West M=4.93, n=117; Program Average M=4.82, n=859, p=.043), 2) Emotional Expression (Wounded Warriors Battalion West M=4.4.88, n=117; Program Average M=4.71, n=861, p=.000), 3) Instructor Time Management/Comfortable Sharing (Wounded Warriors Battalion West M=4.93, n=117; Program

Average M=4.82, n=856, p=.022), 4) Effect of Workshop (Wounded Warriors Battalion West M=4.88, n=117; Program Average M=4.69, n=858, p=.009), 5) Willingness to refer a friend (Wounded Warriors Battalion West M=4.91, n=117; Program Average M=4.72, n=859, p=.000, 6) Interest in additional workshops (Wounded Warriors Battalion West M=4.91, n=117; Program Average M=4.79, n=858, p=.000). In one area, San Onofre School reported significantly lower that the instructor was approachable and/or cared about them than the averages of all programs (San Onofre School M=4.82, n=209; Program Average M=4.87, n=858, p=.04). Although there were differences in the overall satisfaction among the different programs, the differences were not significant and could be a result of statistical error.

Categorical Variable: Ethnicity

There was a one-way analysis of variance (ANOVA) test computed for the categorical variable client ethnicity for the 2018-2020 combined adult and child data. The six types of client ethnicities identified were 1) Caucasian, 2) African American/Black, 3) Hispanic/Latinx American, 4) Asian American/Vietnamese, 5) Other (including bi-racial). The client indicated their ethnicity on their client survey. There were six significant differences in the eight outcome measures among the five ethnic groups. The participants that identified as Asian American/Vietnamese reported 1) liking the workshop more (Asian American/Vietnamese M=4.921, n=76; Ethnicity average M=4.82, n=680, p=.011), 2) workshop helped express more (Asian American/Vietnamese M=4.93, n=76; Ethnicity average M=4.75, n=680, p=.002), and 3) they felt better after taking the workshop (Asian American/Vietnamese M=4.88, n=76; Ethnicity average M=4.71, n=679, p=.011) than other ethnicities. Additionally, the Asian American/Vietnamese participants felt the instructor was more approachable and appeared to care about participants (Asian American/Vietnamese M=4.95, n=76; Ethnicity average M=4.87, n=680, p=.006) and value their time more than other ethnicities (Asian American/Vietnamese M=4.95, n=76; Ethnicity average M=4.88, n=680, p=.006). Finally, the clients that identified as Asian American/Vietnamese ethnicities were more likely to refer a friend or family member (Asian American/Vietnamese M=4.88, n=76; Ethnicity average M=4.77, n=680, p=.000) than other identified ethnicities, in particular those who indicated other or bi-racial group.

Independent Samples T-test

The Independent Samples T-Test compares the means of two independent groups in order to determine whether there is statistical evidence that the associated population means are significantly different. The two groups (child and adult) were compared among the eight outcome variables 1) How Great the Workshop, 2) Emotional Expression, 3) Caring Instructor, 4) Instructor Time Management/Comfortable Sharing, 5) Effect of Workshop, 6) Willingness to refer a friend, 7) Interest in additional workshops, and 8) Overall Satisfaction.

There were 8 significant differences among the child participants and adult participants. Adult participants reported higher averages on 1) This workshop was great (t=1.49, p=.001) 2) This workshop helped me share my feelings/express my emotions (t=5.44, p=.000), 3) The instructor was approachable and appeared to care about the participants (t=2.54, p=.000), 4) The instructor was on time and valued my time (t=3.29, p=.000), 5) I feel better after taking this workshop (t=1.89, p=.000), 6) I would tell a friend or family member to attend this workshop (t=7.85, p=.000), 7) I want to take another Art & Creativity for Healing workshop (t=1.69, p=.000), 8) Overall, I like this workshop/I am satisfied with this Art & Creativity for Healing workshop (t=1.43, p=.003).

LIMITATIONS

While the data was evaluated by consultants independently from program management and staff, the program staff did collect all responses and enter the data into SurveyMonkey. Overall, this data evaluation has a respectable sample size and can generally be regarded to be an accurate indicator of the measured items.

It is important to emphasize that while correlations show the degree to which two numerical variables co-relate, they cannot measure other types of relationships. Because two variables are correlated does not necessarily mean that one variable causes the other to occur. The one significant correlation we did find was for the eight rating variables on the participant questionnaire which are all highly face valid.

ANOVAs can only be used when the groups are independent from each other. When completing a one-way ANOVA we are not able to see the possible interactions between the multiple numerical variable. Finally, we are not able to find the actual cause of the difference in means, only that there is a difference.
